Dr. Daniel Müller is deputy head of the Department Structural Change at the Leibniz-Institute of Agricultural Development in Transition Economies (IAMO) and lecturer in geography at Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin. The overall goal of his research program is to identify pathways towards more sustainable land use. Dr. Müller and his team contribute towards better understanding the causes and consequences of land-system changes, options to mitigate greenhouse gas emissions in the land-use sector, and the impacts of climate change on crop production. His methodological portfolio includes a wide range of quantitative tools, including spatial statistics, econometrics, remote sensing, and machine learning, which he uses to combine his expertise in resource economics and natural sciences. The geographic focus of his research are the countries of the former Soviet Union, is Southeastern Europe, and China.
