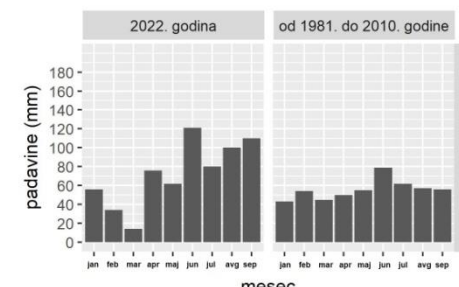
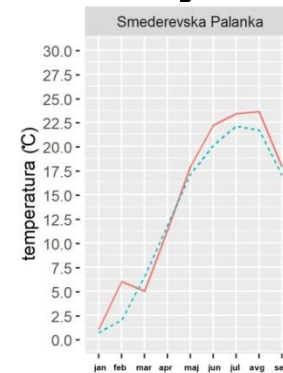
Climatic characteristics of the production year 2022:



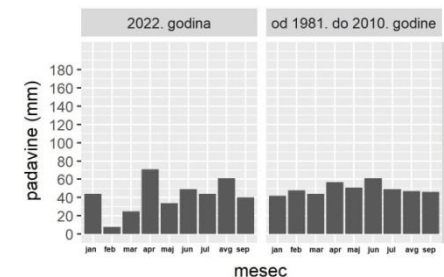
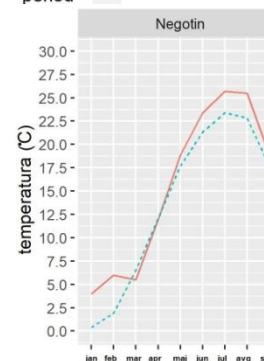

The amount of grapes produced in the 2022 harvest:

- 162.000t (prediction RSO)
- +4% 2021

Quality of grapes of white and black wine varieties from the vintage 2022:

- Depending of region and varieties
- Generally:
 - lower sugar content
 - normal or higher pH
 - Problems with botrytis

Quantity of certified organic grapes in 2022:

- Data will be available in January 2022
- 2021:
 - Organic vineyards – 40,92 ha
 - Conversion – 132,13 ha
 - Organic grape – 277,72 t

Prediction of the future quality of wine from the vintage 2022:

- Not better than 2021?
